Additional Weight -

Horses that at entry have or are
eligible for a published rating - for
every 1lb above the rating of 75 1lb extra

Horses that at entry do not have a
published rating (Band A 76-80) 5lb extra

Horses that at entry do not have a
published rating (Band B 81-85) 10lb extra

Horses that at entry do not have a
published rating (Band C 86-90) 15lb extra

After time of entry - for each race
won 7lb extra

Horses that at entry do not have a published
handicap rating are eligible to enter and run
at the discretion of the handicapper and the
handicapper may place these horses into
any of the above rating bands or permit
these horses to run off the base weight.

Note, the placing of a horse without a
published rating into a rating band is at the
discretion of the handicapper and is not a
commitment to a future official rating.

Horses that at entry do not have a published
handicap rating but previously had a
published handicap rating may, at the
discretion of the handicapper, have a
published handicap rating applied after the
time of entry for the purpose of the
application of additional weight.

Horses that at entry do not have a published
handicap rating but are eligible for a
published handicap rating may, at the
discretion of the handicapper, have a
published handicap rating applied prior to
the calculation of weights for the purpose of
the application of additional weight.
